LEVEL 5 | 18 CREDITS

This course prepares the student to participate in an Incident Management team during the initial response phase of a Search and Rescue operation including operational pre-planning; conducting search urgency assessments; collecting information for the initial response; applying lost person behavior theory during an initial response period; applying reflex tasking; establishing and confining the initial search area; applying decision pointing; and assigning search and rescue resources during the initial response period.

Students will develop an understanding of lost person behavior and how it affects the search planning process.

This is a challenging three day course that involves theory and considerable scenario based practice. Some pre course work is required but there is no post course work.
