SAR 901 MARINE MANAGE THE INITIAL RESPONSE

LEVEL 5 | 18 CREDITS

Marine Manage the Initial Response is a newly developed course that has been introduced into the search and rescue sector. This course is the foundation block for incident management in a marine environment.

The course takes participants through the procedures to be followed from the onset of the notification and includes chart course plotting, wind speed/direction and drift patterns pertaining to different vessels/people in the water. It also teaches about coordination of assets and drives home the importance of managing an incident by objectives, with a number of Incident Action Plans being produced. Importantly to keep the course as real as possible the interactive scenarios are real life ones that are occurred locally (NZ) with minor adaptations.

The course is run over three days and has been established for members of the search and rescue sector who get involved with an incident on the water.
