Lost person behaviour is examined for various categories of people; this leads to the development of particular search strategies for different types of lost people.

As in a real SAR operation, students work in groups practicing and refining a number of well-known best-practice techniques for searching. Specific techniques for both day and night searching, as well as for different environments, are also covered.

The factors which affect the search for a person or object are explored, allowing students to become more aware of environmental and personal reasons that would affect their searching.

This two day course is made up of both theory and practical work - students spend most of their time outside learning and demonstrating search techniques.
