This two day course provides an introduction to tracking theory for SAR field team members. Observational skills are developed, so that sign or clues can be found, it also gives students plenty of field based skills practice.

Students learn about the sign left by people as they travel through the environment, and develop tracking skills to follow an individual in the wilderness. They learn about the use of tracking sticks, using a light source to help with the tracking process and about the importance of processing a clue site correctly, so that they gain the maximum information from it.

Some pre course is required but there is no post course work.
