LEVEL 4 | 12 CREDITS

The two day search course will enable students to apply Lost Person Behaviour to determine search strategies and potential find locations in a suburban search situation.

While on the course students learn to explain the relationships between wilderness and suburban search operations that will enable them to analyse environmental factors impacting on a given suburban search.

As a member of a suburban search team, students will interview members of the public, record search data, manage risk and conduct a property search.

This course combines theory and practical with students spending most of their time out in the community conducting a
